Civics Day



Statue To Be Dedicated in Honor of John P. Connors



A statue sculpted in the likeness of **John P. Connors '82** will be dedicated in the Scituate commons to honor all of the town's veterans who have sacrificed their lives in the line of duty.

John, a local of Scituate, attended BC High and continued his studies at Worcester Polytechnic Institute. After graduation, he joined the Navy and became a Navy Seal. John passed away on December 20, 1989, during Operation Just Cause in Paitilla, Panama. He was posthumously awarded the Silver Star for his bravery and selflessness in combat.
