



Temporary High School English Teacher

PREAMBLE

Boston College High School is a Catholic, Jesuit, independent school serving approximately 1400 young men across grades 7-12 from various communities across Massachusetts. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This is a temporary, full time English teaching position for some or all of the remaining 2024-2025 school year, specific end date to be determined. This job entails teaching four sections of high school English (two of ninth-grade English I and two of tenth-grade English II). In addition to classroom English instruction, this teacher will also need to fulfill various student mentoring and prefecting roles throughout the school.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- A passion for literature and teaching English to high school students of different abilities and backgrounds
- A bachelor's degree in English (a master's degree in English, Education, or other relevant field preferred, but not required)
- Previous experience teaching English at the high school level (preferred, but not required)
- A strong foundation in and knowledge of literature, language, and the craft of writing
- A willingness and enthusiasm to work in a collaborative department and also reflect on and develop one's own pedagogy
- A commitment to working within and supporting both BC High's Jesuit identity and its diversity, equity, and inclusion practices
